General info about the Baltics Digital Skills Development Program

<p>What is Baltics Digital Skills Development Program?</p>	<p>Baltic Digital Skills Development program is established within the framework of Microsoft Global skilling initiative and will be based on Microsoft Learn role-based learning.</p> <p>Main focus of the program is to equip audience with computing and AI skills by offering learning pathways and credentials, and by offering "Learning-by-doing" approach to apply newly acquired skills into the "real-life" work experience.</p> <p>The program consists of two modules – the first module Data and Business Analytics and the second module "Low-code, No-code platform fundamentals".</p> <p>Participant can choose to learn one or another module or both.</p> <p>More info can be find in the program landing pages for each country Latvia, Lithuania, Estonia</p>
<p>Do i have to pay to participate at the program?</p>	<p>Studies are free of charge except if you decide to continue studies and prepare for an exam to get a Microsoft Certificate, then certain fees apply.</p>
<p>Do I need any specific skill in order to finish the program?</p>	<p>No tech background required, but basic English language skills, mainly reading skills is needed and computer skills, including basic skills to use MS Office software</p>
<p>Can I change the module during the learning course?</p>	<p>You can change the module during the course, but in order to receive the necessary information and get access to recordings and learning materials reach out to e-mail: skills@lu.lv</p>

Would we have access to use power platform during the learning period to gain practice?	You can access the Power Platform through a Microsoft account. If you do not have a Microsoft account, follow the instructions.

I would appreciate a mention to low code/no code cloud platforms offered by other companies (Amazon/Google) and what made you choose Microsoft Azure among the other options	<p>Microsoft Power Platform is a group of products offered by Microsoft to develop and build complex business solutions, analyze data, automate a business process, build virtual agents and create apps.</p> <p>The aim of the course is to introduce with Microsoft low-code/no code products.</p>
What are the limitations of powerapps (for the future) and workarounds?	Some of the limitations will be mentioned by the industry in their examples.
Do we have to have the tools downloaded for the next meeting?	It's optional, but you can already do it.

Does these tools require Administrator rights for installation on computer?	No.

Will I be able to use this Virtual Agent in my website? How it will be connected?	More details on Power Virtual Agents will be in the 5 th meeting, taking place on March 3, 2021.
Multiple practical exercises require Dataverse+MS Dynamics 365 + Power Apps, which means all of them should be connected under one account. If you will provide access to Power BI, Power Aps etc separately, will we have the necessary infrastructure to actually complete the practical tasks?"	You will have the necessary infrastructure to complete the practical task. The first essential practical work will start with the 3rd module.
How to get access to Power BI?	Please find instruction how to install and get access to Power BI tool.
Do we should have PowerBI PRO?	No, you don't have to. In the margins of the course, it will be sufficient to have Power BI Desktop, that is for free. Here's how to get started with Power BI .
I have a problem with a module "Create a data-driven story with Power BI reports" in the Business and Data Analysis course. This module is a huge theoretical enumeration of practical features, and there is a lab in the end. Students are supposed to log into a VM, open a report and practice with it, but the file is inaccessible. What should we do?	Log in to a VM, open File Explorer and browse to D:\DA100\Lab09A\Starter and open Sales Report.pbix file
Currently I am reviewing section - Create dashboards in Power BI, and in the part - Lab - Create a Power BI dashboard there is reference to the Sales Report file Adventure Works which was to be set up in previous lessons;	In Power BI Desktop, navigate to D:\DA100\Lab09A\Starter folder, and open Sales Report.pbix file The best way is to set up the report file following the lab: https://docs.microsoft.com/en-us/learn/modules/data-driven-story-power-bi/13-lab
