



#### General info about the Baltics Digital Skills Development Program


<p>What is Baltics Digital Skills Development Program?</p>	<p>Baltic Digital Skills Development program is established within the framework of <a href="#">Microsoft Global skilling initiative</a> and will be based on <a href="#">Microsoft Learn</a> role-based learning.</p> <p>Main focus of the program is to equip audience with computing and AI skills by offering learning pathways and credentials, and by offering "Learning-by-doing" approach to apply newly acquired skills into the "real-life" work experience.</p> <p>The program consists of two modules – the first module Data and Business Analytics and the second module "Low-code, No-code platform fundamentals".</p> <p>Participant can choose to learn one or another module or both.</p> <p>More info can be find in the program landing pages for each country <a href="#">Latvia</a>, <a href="#">Lithuania</a>, <a href="#">Estonia</a></p>
<p>Do I have to pay to participate at the program?</p>	<p>Studies are <b>free of charge</b> except if you decide to continue studies and prepare for an exam to get a Microsoft Certificate, then certain fees apply.</p>

<p>How to get access to Power BI?</p>	<p>Please find <a href="#">instruction</a> how to install and get access to Power BI tool.</p>
<p>Do we should have Power BI PRO?</p>	<p>No, you don't have to. In the margins of the course, it will be sufficient to have Power BI Desktop, that is for free. Here's how to get started with <a href="#">Power BI</a>.</p>
<p>What i have to do when data (in visuals) does not show in LAB when I open them in Power BI?</p>	<p>Data is not automatically showing in Power BI Desktop if it is not previously loaded to it. You need to load new data using Get Data function or use Power BI Desktop file with loaded data. </p>
<p>Will someone explain how to install Power apps?</p>	<p>More instructions and guidelines for Power Apps installation will be provided in the upcoming webinars.</p>
<p>The content of this program, does it have any similarities with the DA-100 material?</p>	<p>Most learning path are the same for DA-100. There are more recourses you can learn.</p>

<p>Am I the only one who cannot do labs, because the data does not show when i open power bi?</p>	<p>Data is not automatically showing in Power BI Desktop if it is not previously loaded to it. You need to load new data using Get Data function or use Power BI Desktop file with loaded data.</p> 
<p>Why in slide is mentioned in Power BI Desktop section ""Python, Themes, RLS creation""? What is the connection between them</p>	<p>You can edit &amp; transform visuals using different tools. Including python scripts. Most of the advanced stuff is done with DAX.</p>
<p>What data and from where to get data? Shall we have some examples of data - excels, web, SQL - or shall we prepare the excel for ourselves</p>	<p>You get XLSX, CSV, SLQ and other data examples in the Microsoft Lab. Just follow the course.</p>
<p>I see in questions several answers regarding virtual machine with Power BI and labs with data there, but don't understand where should I see it? I have completed already 6 modules from the 1st block, but haven't seen any virtual machine or lab option there.</p>	<p>Keep studying. The LAB will soon be available. You can also jump right to it.</p>
<p>Is it possible to import data sets from other BI tools such as Looker?</p>	<p>It is possible to import data sets from other tools if they are stored in one of supported connectors <a href="https://docs.microsoft.com/en-us/power-bi/connect-data/desktop-data-sources">https://docs.microsoft.com/en-us/power-bi/connect-data/desktop-data-sources</a>. If it is not supported we advice to export data from Looker to CSV and then import into Power BI Desktop.</p>
<p>Can I connect it to Bloomberg or Factset data?</p>	<p>Usually commercial platforms are protected from data extraction, but you can try WEB or CSV connector: <a href="https://docs.microsoft.com/en-us/power-bi/connect-data/desktop-connect-to-web-by-example">https://docs.microsoft.com/en-us/power-bi/connect-data/desktop-connect-to-web-by-example</a></p>

<p>I try the sample data as shown but I cannot load. (Icon is blanked and what shown in video is yellowish) I mean that I try to ""get sample data"" into my PBI desktop, it can connect as normal but when the table is viewed on screen, I cannot select the icon to ""load"" it. Any procedure is wrong and how I can achieve it ?</p>	<p>Maybe you need to select table you want to select by checking checkbox:</p> 
<p>What can be the problem the load do not works then want get data from exel in Power BL Desktop?</p>	<p>Power BI is not working with old Excel versions with .xls extension, open file in Excel and save it as .xlsx.</p>
<p>Is there a detection and elimination of outliers feature in Power BI?</p>	<p>There are several ways how to do it with built in functions ( <a href="https://powerbi.microsoft.com/en-us/blog/anomaly-detection-preview/">https://powerbi.microsoft.com/en-us/blog/anomaly-detection-preview/</a> ) or DAX: <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=RogINZ2dXW8">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=RogINZ2dXW8</a></p>

Is there a back button in data modification/transformation?  
 Yes, you can navigate all changes in Power Query using Applied steps window: <https://docs.microsoft.com/en-us/power-bi/transform-model/desktop-query-overview>

What does it mean: ""Unpivot other columns""? What happens to the data in this case?  
 It means you can transform selected columns into attribute-value pairs where columns become rows. Practically it means you split column values from table view to record view:



It is needed to be able to get to transactional type of data and do new aggregations.

In table relationships view there is a possibility to create multiple sheets. For what reason?
