The Erlangen Karzer until 1838

- 1743 Foundation of the university Establishment of the first Karzer in the university building, the so called *"Neumayers Burg*"
- After 1784 another Karzer over the Anatomical Theatre
- 1828 Transfer of the Karzer into the Redoutenhaus

The Erlangen Karzer from 1839 onwards

- 1705 Construction of the water tower as a water reservoir for the fountains in the margravial residence park
- 1818 Handover to the university after the death of the last margravine
- 1838 Transfer of the Karzer into the water tower
- 1898 Transfer of the Karzer to the attic of the Geological Institute in the park of the Erlangen residence
- 1913 Abolition of the Karzer punishment

Tradition of the Karzer in the water tower

- 1839 Establishment in the water tower until 1898
 Remaining of a Karzer room from this epoch time until today
- 1919 Use of the tower as a local history museum
- 1962 Conversion as a bratwurst restaurant
- 2003 Restoration and new use as a music school til today




