- Slovenia.

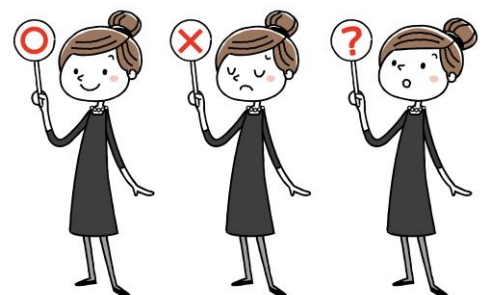
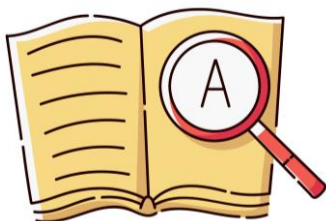


The partners will make a lot of things.

- **make rules** for Easy-to-read information in Latvia and Lithuania.



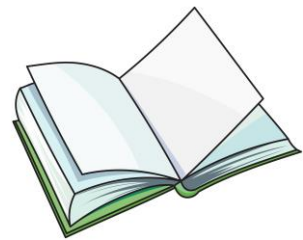
The partners will also:
