- *You CAN take some courses form other faculties, but for that you need to contact coordinator of that faculty!*
- *Attending classes is **MANDATORY**, if there is some urgent case and you cant attend, you need to inform professor!*

**ONLINE application to courses via [luis.lv](https://luis.lv) system:**

*You all shall receive, if not yet received, login and passwords from my colleagues at the International Mobility Division (you must change password, as it is written there)*

1. *Login in luis*
2. *Read and accept internal rules (!!!)*
3. *Change to English (upper right corner)*
4. *Click on profile*
5. *Left side there will be option “Apply for courses (ERASMUS)”*
6. *Make your choice*
7. *On Septmeber 1st, you all will be registered to courses, according to your choice in luis system.*

*Please, be aware that there is limited number of places for each course, and if there will be more applications than there are places, those who have applied first, will be registered to the course.*

*Do not apply for more courses than you need.*

***IMPORTANT!!! Online application will be open from 29.08. (00:00) to 30.08. (24:00) -***

*It means as soon as its midnight and date changes to 29.08., you can already log in LUIS and register!*
