














Mentoring







The mentor contributes informed observations and advice to aid decision making.

All applications for mentor assistance are dealt with individually and are preceded by a business needs analysis to assess the key needs of the business and determine the most relevant mentoring objectives

Trading Online Voucher





What is a TOV?

The voucher is a financial grant to small businesses to develop or enhance their ability to trade online, by enhancing or creating a website

A business may apply for funding to a maximum value of €2,500 or 50% of eligible expenditure (exclusive of VAT), whichever is the lesser

Qualifying Criteria for a TOV

You must: Be trading for at least 6 months; Have 10 employees or fewer; Less than €2m turn turn Attend a TOV Training Seminar with your Local Enterprise Office in the previous 9 months

Important: Voucher approval must be gained prior to incurring any expense

Voucher Application: With your application, you will need to submit three quotes for work - Click to read a handy guide to getting a quote for your website
