
Latvia is one of the world's greenest countries - over 44% of its territory covered by forests



University of Latvia

- Founded in 1919
- **15 250** students, over 1000 academic and 1000 non-academic staff
- 13 faculties with more than 150 study programmes in natural, exact, social sciences and humanities.
- 3 colleges and 7 regional branches
- 19 scientific institutes specialising in 50 research areas
 - In 2021, UL started implementation of the **182 projects** (out of them: 24 of EU structural funds, 12 Horizon2020 & ERA-NET, 18 Erasmus+)
 - 2004-2014: the UL participated in more than
 350 EU and EEA / Norge/ INTERREG/ Erasmus+ funded projects.

Support for students:

- □ Ukrainian students and researchers are provided with opportunity to continue their studies and research in UL and to receive state-funded scholarships and paid internships.
- □ All Ukrainian students are subject to a 100% reduction in tuition fees.
- ☐ Free of charge accommodation in UL student house.




Support for academic staff:

- □ Opportunity to continue academic work and research
- ☐ Free of charge stay in UL student house (academic staff and their family members).

Other support measures – free of charge legal assistance, psychological counselling, various social events and activities, additional support from Funds collected at the UL charity concert.

Ukrainians in Latvia (1)

- ☐ Latvia has welcomed around 40 thousands of Ukrainians since February.
- ☐ Various support measures from government, NGOs, municipalities, businesses and individuals have been introduced to help Ukrainian civilians.
- ☐ Measures and initiatives such as grants, housing, medical aid, scholarship, language courses, work opportunities are available.



Ukrainians in Latvia (2)

- ☐ 17 452 Ukrainians received financial allowance (amount of min wage) to start their work or self-employment activity in 2022
- ☐ Ukrainian refugees in Latvia mostly perform low-skilled jobs.
- ☐ The main obstacle to join labour market is language barrier.
- ☐ It is more difficult to find job for those Ukrainian refugees who are accommodated in the most remote parts of Latvia.
- □ e.g. in December 2022, the majority of job offers for Ukrainian civilians were in the following sectors (CSP, 2022):
 - IT /Telecommunications, Construction/Real Estate, Manufacturing, Transportation/Logistics, Agriculture/Environment, Services, Trade/Marketing, Food Industry/Catering.

The Social Mentor Support

by Society Integration Foundation (SIF)

- **Aim**: support for dealing with everyday situations, including employment opportunities. The assistance service is offered at individual level for 60) days (in English, Ukrainian, Russian languages). Ensured through different NGOs and local municipalities.
- ☐ **Timing**: 01.05.2022 up to date
- □ **Stakeholders:** Ministry of Welfare, municipalities (43), NGOs (7)- "DOMUS", "Caritas Latvija", "Shelter "Safe House"", educational centre "FIBRA", the foundation "Ventspils High Technology Park", etc.
- □ **Results**: it is foreseen to support ~7 000 Ukraine people within 43 municipalities.
- □ **Resources needed**: 700 000 Eur budget financed by the European Social Fund (project "Promoting Diversity") (85% and state budget (15%)





Common Ground – a social initiative centre

- A private initiative established immediately after war started by the members of the Riga International Biennial of Contemporary Art and "Hanzas perons" team together with like-minded partner institutions, caring individuals, artists, professionals, numerous volunteers.
- Socialising and information exchange place and platform
- Offers library, coworking space, playrooms for kids, quiet room.
- The centre offers a wide range of social events and recreational activities for children, youth and adults (including art classes, language lessons, mindful practices, etc.), livelihood programmes, information about work opportunities, as well as legal consultations and psychosocial support, the centre stands as a safe space for information exchange.

Common Ground – a social initiative centre

- **Timing:** 26.02.2022- present
- **Stakeholders**: Riga city council, organisation "Gribu palīdzēt bēgļiem» (I want to help refugees), cafe "Borsch", etc.
- **Results achieved**: more than social, cultural and recreational activities organised, more than 20,000 people visited the centre in 2022.
- **Resources needed**: space, 4 employed persons, 200 voluntary persons.
- Financed with private and company donations.
- From the historic premises of old train station moved to the old town in the premises of city council and where united with other organisations supporting Ukraine.


