The ageing society is a Europe 2020 societal challenge and represents a tremendous business opportunity for companies operating in the health sector.



Objective of InnovaSPA project



Exchanges of experiences between 8 thermal regions in Europe on issues related to health innovation linked to thermalism

The project will identify and transfer good territorial policies or instruments developed by Managing Authorities and dedicated to thermal innovation in the field of preventative health, with a strong focus on the involvement of public authorities, academic institutions and cluster organisations in the local decision making process. **Relevant policies will then be transferred among the project partners.**

Phase 1 : 2,5 years from June 2018 to November 2020

Phase 2: 2 years from December 2020 to 2022

Phase 1

- Reciprocal Improvement Analysis (based on SWOT analysis of the territories and the collect of Good practices form the partner organisations)
- Exchanges of Good Practices based on the organisation of 8 study visits (one per country)
- Action Plans creation in order to improve the regional or national public policies targeted by the project
