Latvians in Europe ...

- ✓ Scattered all over Europe
- ✓ Largest communities in the UK, Ireland, Germany, Norway, Sweden
- ✓ Meet mainly through common educational, cultural and artistic activity
 - +/- 26 formal and informal associations (15 linked to the ELA)
 - 30 Latvian heritage schools
 - 15 groups of choir and dancing activity
 - 2 local chambers of commerce
 - 7 mediums of communication (3 newspapers and 4 internet portals)

The ELA is ...

- ✓ The voice of the European Latvian diaspora in Latvia, Europe and in the world
- ✓ Established in 1951, but registered as NGO in Latvia since 2010
- ✓ Has 15 member organizations from 10 European countries other than Latvia
- ✓ Member of the World Federation of Free Latvians (PBLA) and of the Europeans throughout the World (ETTW)
- ✓ Addresses actively Latvian officials, local governments, businesses, NGOs

Diaspora's economic impact...

- ✓ Remittances (351 milj. lats or 2% of GDP in 2011)
- ✓ Market for Latvian goods and services, possibly
- ✓ Sales agents, possibly
- ✓ Source of qualified labor, possibly
- ✓ Source of human capital, possibly
- ✓ Source of financial capital, possibly

The ever increasing presence of Latvian people in Europe is an opportunity for Latvia, not a loss ...

but...

- ... before benefits arrive, certain adjustment in people's perception and in national policies is required
- ✓ UNDERSTAND THAT MIGRATION IS NORMALITY fierce competition for people; labor recruiting strategy
- ✓ RECOGNIZE THE POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC IMPORTANCE OF DIASPORA think positively; encourage networking
- ✓ Notice that diaspora networking is a contact sport be patient; find leaders; build professional networks
- ✓ ASSIST NEW DIASPORA ASSOCIATIONS limited capacity; support educational and cultural projects

Europe should help...

Free movement of people is a founding principle of the EU:

✓ Latvia - 10%, USA - 7%, old EU - 2.3%

Without compensatory transfers, it weakens the fiscal position of sending countries:

✓ Latvia - 2.4%, USA - 15%

Provokes the issue of preservation of migrants' national identity:

✓ European citizens concept should include cultural and linguistic rights
